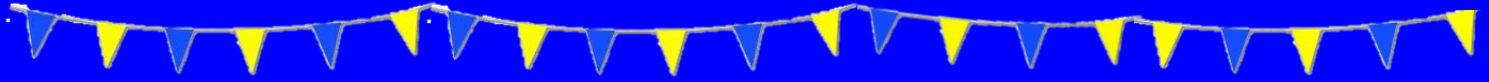


# Reception Newsletter
