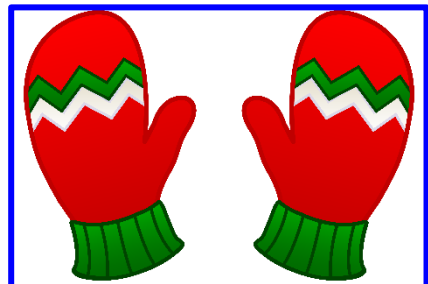
Topics and Other Info...
