## Reading Book/Word Envelope's...

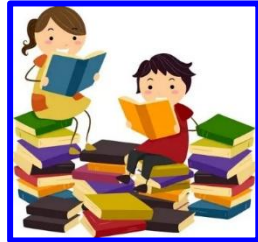
Please remember to comment on how your child is getting on with their reading books, home is a completely different environment than reading in school, so your comments help us get a rounded view of your child's progress.
