No queuing system is needed when the children come into school in the morning; they can come straight in. This means that children aren't waiting too long and there is less chance of any upset. If your child is having a very unsettled morning, just hang back with them if you need to and let Mrs Watt or Mrs Harris know when your child is more settled and you're ready for us to take over. We will always contact you to let you know your child has settled, which is usually really quickly because they see their friends and favourite toys.
