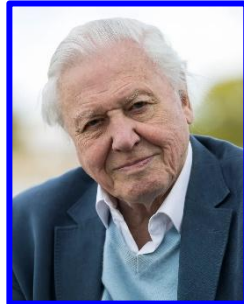

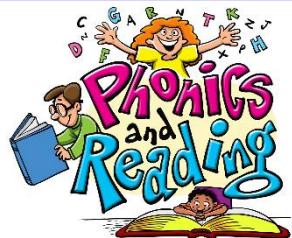

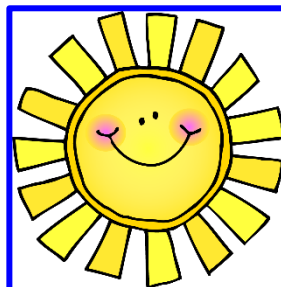


### Phonics Books
