Next week we are going to find out more about London. If your child has visited London, you might like to send a couple of photos in on Seesaw.

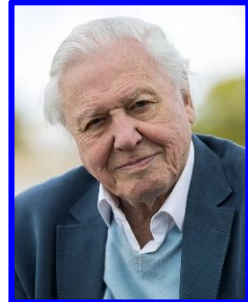
