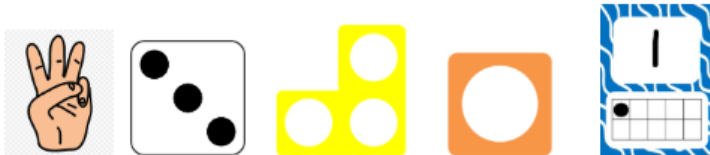
Weekly Round-Up Spring 2 Week 6
