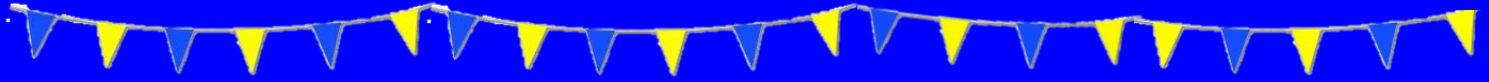

What have we been up to?

This week, we have been taking part in lots of science activities linked to our new topic - 'Springtime'. Our focus has been on how seeds grow and change into plants and flowers. We have enjoyed investigating different types of seeds, looking at the shapes, sizes and colours of them and wondering what flowers/plants they might grow into. This week, the children have enjoyed planting sunflowers seeds and broad bean seeds and are caring for them so well by making sure they have plenty of sunlight and water. We will enjoy observing how they grow and change over the next few weeks.

We have also celebrated World Book Day. We had a fabulous day participating in many activities linked to our chosen book 'You Choose'. Please have a look a See-saw to see all the exciting things we got up to. Many thanks for all the parents/carers for the costumes too. The children looked AMAZING!

In maths this week, we have been learning some mathematical vocabulary linked to capacity e.g. 'full' and 'empty'. The children have loved filling and emptying different sized containers and explaining how they know they are full or empty. We have even used harder language such as 'nearly full and nearly empty' too - what clever clogs the children are! Super work!
