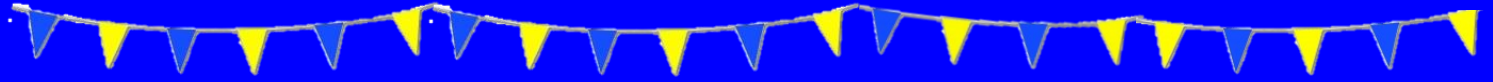

In maths this week, we have been using the story 'Goldilocks and the three bears' to discuss the language of size and also to count, recognise and subitise the numerals 1,2,3. We have been talking about how we can show these numbers by holding up our fingers e.g. to make two we could hold up 2 fingers from one hand or one finger from the left hand and one from the right hand) We have also been introducing the children to the Numicon pieces 1,2, and 3.
