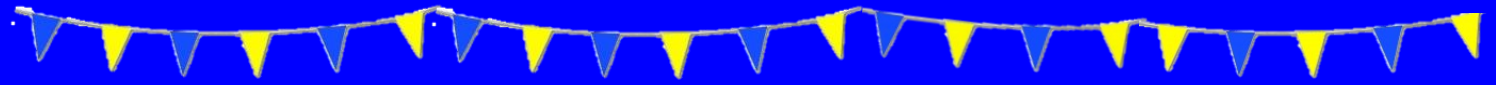

What have we been up to?

This week in Nursery, we have continued our 'Farm' topic. We have been learning all about cows and talking about where milk and milk products come from. The children loved pretending to squirt milk from a makeshift udder into a bucket, and later in the week we will be making our own butter to spread on toast during snack time. Of course, we have also been enjoying learning lots of interesting facts about cows.

This week is Mental Health Awareness Week. In Nursery we have been supporting this by talking about our feelings and emotions. We have enjoyed reading the story of 'The Colour Monster' to help us recognise and understand different emotions. We have also practised mindfulness techniques, such as deep rainbow breathing, to help us feel calm and relaxed. The children have also enjoyed spending time in the sensory room, exploring different sounds, textures and lights to support their wellbeing.

In maths, we have been learning about the position of objects and using positional language. We read a lovely farm story and talked about where the animals and other objects were in the pictures, using our oracy skills to describe their positions. The children also enjoyed exploring the illustrations in books in our reading corner, identifying characters and objects in different places. They did a fantastic job using this mathematical vocabulary.
