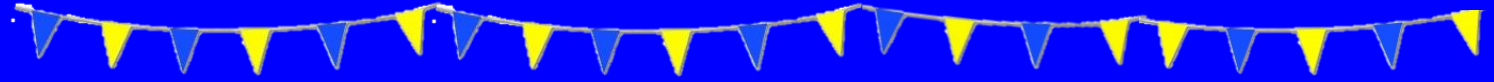


Nursery Newsletter

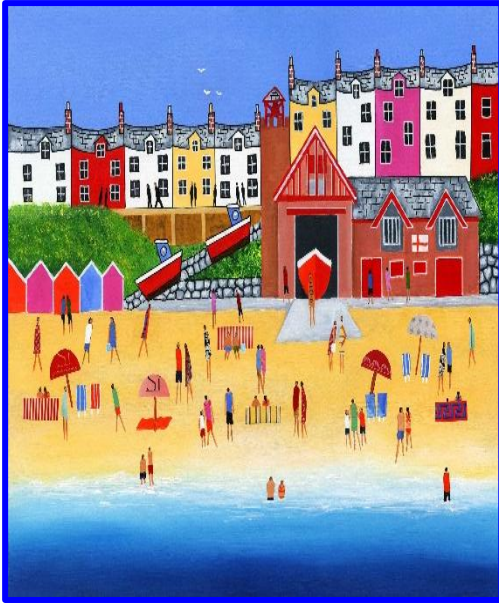
End of Term Nursery Stay & Play
