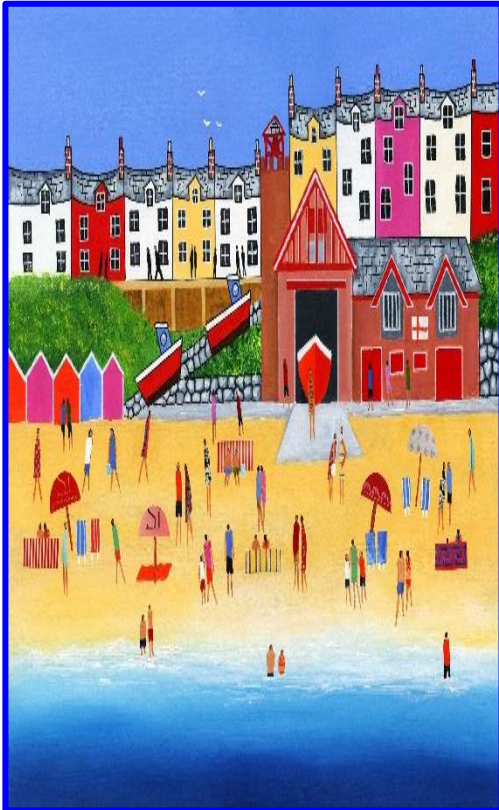
Goodbye and Good Luck...
