With artificial intelligence becoming an increasingly common part of children's online experiences, it is important that they have the skills and confidence to make safe and informed choices when using smart technology.

Throughout the week, the children will be taking part in activities that explore what AI is, how it is used in everyday life, and how it can be used positively. They will also discuss the importance of using technology responsibly, thinking critically about online information, and knowing how to stay safe when interacting with digital tools.

The focus of these sessions is to empower children to understand both the benefits and potential risks of AI and to encourage thoughtful and safe decision-making when using technology.
