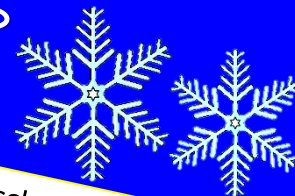

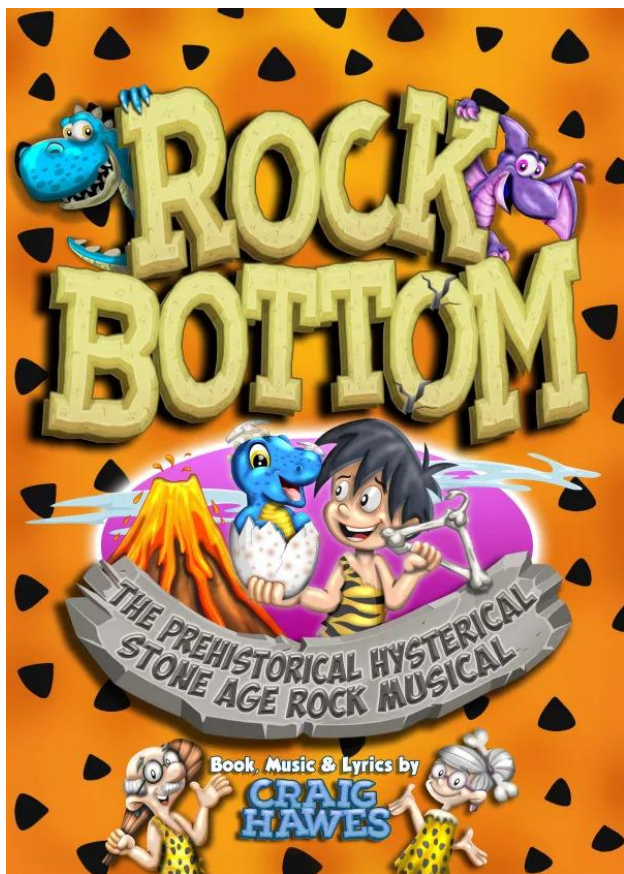

Over the past year funds have been used to:

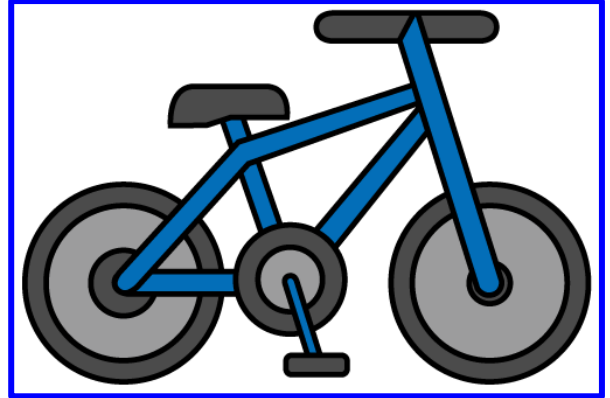
- Contribute £1000 towards the Christmas panto
